TRICORNE AUDIO, INC. TAKES SOUND TO NEW HEIGHTS WITH INSTALLATION OF JBL CONTROL 321 LOUDSPEAKERS AT ZION LUTHERAN CHURCH'S CHRISTIAN LIFE CENTER

NORTHRIDGE, CALIFORNIA, November 6, 2006 — Underscoring the pattern control and ease of installation of the JBL Professional Control® Contractor Series, Zion Lutheran Church's Christian Life Center in Grand Rapids, MN recently underwent a retrofit of its audio system courtesy of Fargo, ND-based Tricorne Audio. The zoned system includes JBL Control 321 in-ceiling loudspeakers.

Adjacent to the Zion Lutheran Church, the Christian Life Center is a 100 x 60-foot open space, which doubles as a gymnasium and fellowship hall, hosting a range of church-related activities and events. Since its initial construction approximately 10 years ago, the Center has relied on portable loudspeakers for its audio. However, it became apparent that a professionally designed and installed audio system was necessary. "It's a large space with a 24-foot-high metal ceiling and tile floors, so we really needed to get the sound under control," said Dallas Anderson of Tricorne Audio.

To that end, Anderson performed an acoustical analysis of the Christian Life Center and hung approximately 40 baffles for acoustical treatment. Using an EASE model to determine the best configuration of the loudspeakers, Anderson chose a distributed system that includes four rows of three JBL Control 321 in-ceiling loudspeakers.

The Control 300 Series large format in-ceiling loudspeakers consists of six full-range true point-source coax designs featuring 8" and 12" drivers, multiple power levels and transformer options, plus a 12" in-ceiling subwoofer. The Control 321C is premium 12" ceiling coax loudspeaker with a power rating of 250 watts and frequency response down to 34 Hz. The Control 300 models were designed to be easier to install than most large format ceiling speakers. The new EZ-Rail™ feature allows installers to hold the loudspeaker in place while fastening, often eliminating the need for a second installer. In addition, the same multi-pin connector as used in the smaller Control Contractor models allows for pre-wiring with simple click-on connection during installation.

According to Anderson, the Control 321's lived up to expectations because of their excellent pattern control and extended bandwidth. "The Control 321's were perfect for this project—we got plenty of low end out of them and they're ready to go right out of the box," Anderson said. "The coverage was very smooth, which has been a problem in the past with other coax speakers. The Control 321's did exactly what the EASE models showed they would do."
